

# How to Object to Peloton's planning application to allow increased traffic on to Garston Industrial Estate

Send letters or emails to Liverpool City Council Planning Department and quote planning reference **22f/2806**

*The deadline for objections is Friday 7th March*

Here's an example of what you could say:

I wish to object to application **22f/2806**, as it will directly affect my (and my children's) quality of life by increased:

- **Air pollution**
- **Road traffic**
- **Noise pollution**
- **Increased risk of accidents**

A facility like this, so close to a community of residential housing, schools and multiple vulnerable resident groups with protected characteristics will likely accelerate ongoing ill health and risk of accidents.
